BHARATPUR: The Keoladeo "Ghana" National Park, is one of the finest water - bird sanctuaries in the world. The Maharaja of Bharatpur artificially created the lake and wetland in the 19th century. By building small decks and dams and diverting water from an irrigation canal, he converted this low-lying area into a fine wild fowl shooting preserve. In a few years, the new wetland surrounded by marginal forests was able to support thousands of water birds.

The Keoladeo "Ghana" National Park was declared a reserve for birds in 1956 and later upgraded to National Park. UNESCO has listed it as a world heritage site.

Commonly referred to as Bharatpur, the Park is a delight for bird watchers. Over 375 species of birds are found here. The raised paths, camouflaged by Babool trees and undergrowth make viewing easy. A quiet ride by boat in the early hours of the morning is also unforgettable experience. The cacophony is unbelievable as Painted Storks, Open Bills, Spoonbills, Egrets, Cormorants, White Ibis and multitudes of others, tend their young. Jacanas with their iridescent colors and elegant tail feathers and Purple Moroccan can be seen delicately treading over the floating vegetation

Fatehpur Sikri

An epic in red sandstone, a city of yesteryears, today lost in the mists of time..... Fatehpur Sikri was built by the Mughal Emperor Akbar during 1564 A.D. A sonless Akbar had gone to Sikri to seek blessings of a muslim saint Sheikh Salim Chishti. When his son was finally born, he in gratitude constructed his capital city and named it Fatehpur Sikri. Later, due to shortage of water and unrest in north-west, Akbar had to abandon this city.

The beautiful marble tomb of Sheikh Salim Chisti attracts thousands who seek blessings of the revered saint. Other renowned places are Diwan-e-Am, Diwan-e-Khaas, Buland Darwaza, Panch Mahal, Jodha Bai's Palace and Birbal Bhavan.

Agra Fort

Built by Emperor Akbar in 1565 A.D. the fort is a masterpiece of design and construction. Within the fort are a number of exquisite buildings, including the Moti Masjid, Diwane-E-Am, Diwani-E-Khaas and Musanman Burj, where the Emperor Shah Jahan died in imprisonment beside Jehangir's palace, Khaas Mahal and the Sheesh Mahal.

Taj Mahal

Agra is famous as being home to one of the seven wonders of the world- the Taj Mahal. Construction of Taj took 22 years and involved a labour force of 20,000 workers. The architectural splendor of the mausoleums, the fort and the palaces in Agra is a vivid reminder of the capital in the 16th and early 17th centuries.

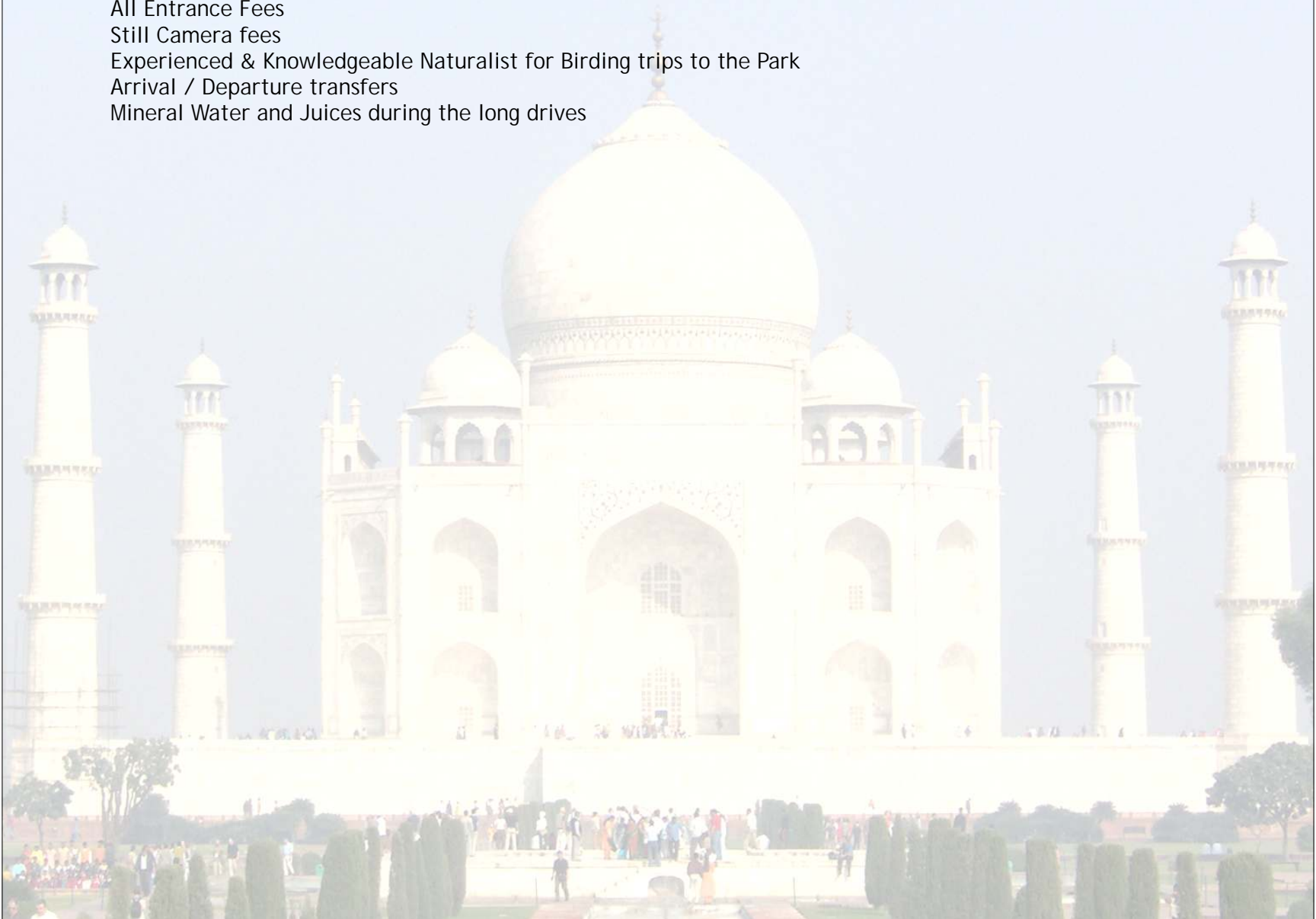
